Criteria

- The Wood Medal is awarded every three years to a fellow of the Society for excellent contributions to economic or social statistics.
- The Wood Medal has limits in terms of the number of years since the award of a first degree. These limits apply to the year in which the RSS award is made, not to the year of nomination, and to the year in which the first degree course was completed, not to the date of formal graduation. If a candidate's first degree is at Master's level, the time limits are reduced by one year.
